Job Posting: General Construction Laborer

Job Description:

The General Construction Labourer will support operations at the LNTCFS mill site located at 4737 Gilbert Drive in Barriere, BC. Duties will vary based on operational needs and individual performance, with opportunities for increased responsibility.

Tasks may include:

- Firewood production stacking/piling firewood
- Mill production and clean-up students under 18 will not work in the production process as per Employment Standards Act requirements for young workers
- Carpentry and finishing assisting with recreation site infrastructure such as tables and outhouses; painting and construction
- General site cleanup and maintenance

Details:

Start Date: As early as May or June; no later than early July 2025 (depending on candidate

availability)

Term: Flexible start, ending by late August 2025 at 40 hours/week

Wage: \$18.00/hour

Closing Date: Open until filled

Qualifications:

Applicants must meet the following funding criteria:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment*
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or have refugee protection under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada

^{*}Must be 15 by the employment start date; may be older than 30 by the end of the term if they were 30 at the start.
